

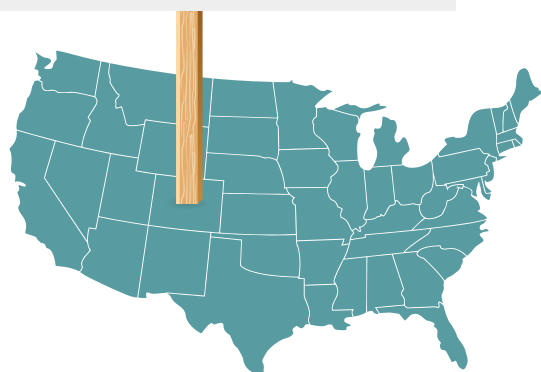

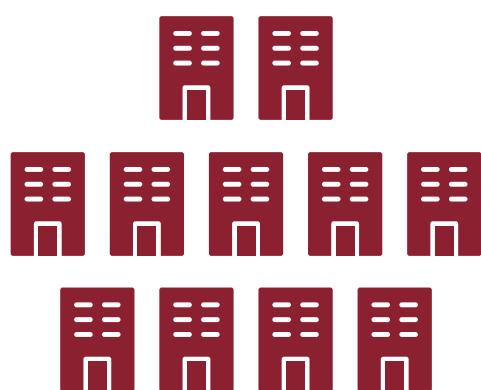
# DU'S PRISON ARTS INITIATIVE
