- 3. Candidates will normally be enrolled in the Pedagogy Certificate program for one year. A candidate may, however, request to remain in the program longer with the stipulation that he/she must enroll in practicum for the duration of their time in the program.

International Students: In order to qualify for an F-1 or J-1 visa, students must enroll in at least eight (8) credit hours per quarter, with the exception of their final quarter at DU. Depending on your program, you may be required to register for credit hours beyond the minimum requirements for your program in order to fulfill the 8-credit requirement.
